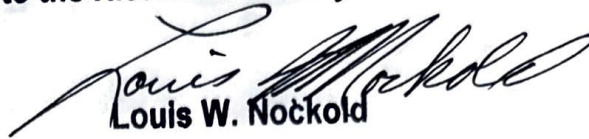
Captain Alvin "Bud" Anderson U. S. Army Air Corps
